Dear Instructor,

- 1) The Instructor is required to have an original transcript on file with MII.
- 2) The Instructor should require students to be 2 weeks ahead in reading material.
- 3) The Instructor will lecture on required weekly material, leaving room for open discussion.
- 4) The Instructor will give 5 minutes of quiet time at the end of teaching for the students to meditate and write their most important thoughts from lecture.
- 5) The Instructor will give time for each student to share their thoughts (2 minute time limit).
- 6) The Instructor will lead prayer and stirring up of spiritual gifts in students (15 to 30 minutes).
- 7) Homework assignment is to read 65 pages per week until book is completed.
- 8) Students are allowed 2 excused absences per course. If they miss more than 2 classes, they must have a written excuse from Employer, Doctor, etc.
- 9) All unexcused absences, after first 2, will result in one letter grade reduction (Example: A to B or B to C).
- 10) Students will not receive credit from any course study until they have paid their tuition and they must have original transcripts on file with MII.
- 11) Students may not attend course without books.
- 12) Cap and Gown Graduation is provided in the cost of course.

Students will need to write a 300 word essay on each course (include each subject in course).

Grades are based on:

- 1) Homework Assignment: Read 65 pages weekly, and do one question and answer on each chapter involved in weekly reading.
Example: (True or False, Fill in the Blank, Multiple Choice - A B C D.) (35%)
- 2) Classroom Participation (15%)
- 3) 300 Word Essay (50%)
